Sangamon Street, situated in the vibrant West Loop neighborhood of Chicago near Mary Bartelme Park. This innovative project, led by developers Fern Hill and Free Market Ventures, is a 33-story tower that will house 283 rental units, including 57 affordable housing options, reflecting the community's growing demand for inclusive urban living.

At the heart of the development is a striking three-story community center and adjoining fieldhouse, offering dynamic spaces for recreation and local events. The project seamlessly integrates residential and public spaces, creating a hub of activity and engagement that enhances the surrounding area.
